#### What to Bring:

Bring your Bible, pencil or pen, a notebook, a sleeping bag or single bunk bedding, towels, soap, toothpaste and tooth brush, insect repellent, tennis shoes and socks, swimsuit, waterproof sunscreen, extra clothes, jacket and fishing gear.

#### What not to bring:

Do not bring radios, TV's, DVD players, or personal electronic games. Apparel for daily wear and especially the evening services, should be modest and appropriate for worshiping God. No bikini or immodest swim wear, or sun-wear.

No fireworks, weapons, or illegal substances. **No food or drinks,** alcoholic drinks, energy drinks or tobacco etc.

All persons are responsible for cleanliness and orderliness of the area in which they live each day. No one is allowed to leave camp without permission of the Camp Dean. Camp visitors who wish to visit Lake Bronson State Park must have a Minnesota Park sticker or a day pass issued when they enter the park. All teens must register their vehicles.

#### Location

Drive on Hwy 59 north from Karlstad to Lake Bronson, MN. Take Co Rd #28 east into Lake Bronson State Park. Stop at park office to tell them you're going to Galilee, and they won't charge you. Turn left at the second left turn and follow the paved road until you get to the sign about 1 mile on your right.

A health record with dates is to be completed and signed by the parent or guardian and to indicate that the camper is fully protected against measles, rubella, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio and mumps.
